As chapters recruit interested aspirants and candidates as new members, please follow these policies in the next steps for those who accept an invitation and start a new member program with you! We continue to offer great outlets with Student Leadership and Civic Engagement, and there is a wonderful reminder to apply for three open positions with the Greek Programming Board (GPB) by September 22.

Fall 2019 Recruitment – Phase 2 DUE within 48 hrs of the start of new member education

Chapters that have completed recruitment events must next complete the **2019-2020 Request for Recruitment Phase 2** in UIC Connection within 48 hours of the start of new member education:

(1) Complete both PAPER documents with required signatures & UINs:

** Immediately during the very first meeting of your selected new members, ensure every new member signs the paper copy of BOTH forms listed below:

(2) Upload both completed documents into the 2019-2020 Request for Recruitment Phase 2 Form in UIC Connection:

** The above steps must be completed within 48 hours of the start of new member education, i.e., 48 hours from the conclusion of the first new member meeting. This due date is based on the date you previously submitted in Phase 1 as the actual start to your own chapter's new member education – the first full gathering in a new member meeting you host. Grades and conduct checks are made from those on the new member list now associated with your organization.

- Failure to submit this information at this critical starting point of your new member education period could put your chapter in jeopardy of holding future meetings with new members and/or suspension of your intake/new member process.

The Greek Programming Board (GPB) is a board comprised of representatives from all five Fraternity and Sorority Life councils at the University of Illinois at Chicago with the purpose of providing diverse quality programs to enhance the Greek Life experience for members of fraternities and sororities on campus. GPB works to improve the Greek Life experience for student organizations through the implementation of six committees:

- Academics & Scholarship
- Development and Education
- Inter-Community Relations
- Marketing
- Outreach & Campus Relations
- Service & Philanthropy

Committees will work to develop and implement programs pertaining to Greek Life and campus relations.

Available positions:

- Vice President of Finance
- Director of Development and Education
- Director of the Outreach & Campus Relations Committee

Position Descriptions:

Vice President of Finance (VPF):

Creates and compiles an overall budget for GPB, and works with GPB Directors to assist them with managing their committee budgets. The VPF assists the President on all financial matters.

Director of the Development & Education Committee:

Orchestrates FSL's informative programs. The committee plans and executes annual events such as Collegiate Greek Institute and National Hazing Prevention Week, as well as special events including wellness programs and new officer training.

Director of the Outreach & Campus Relations Committee:

Manages FSL's external operations. The committee plans and executes promotional Greek events such as Meet the Greeks as well as special events, collaboration with UIC Orientation, and general FSL publicity events.

Appointment Process:

Applications will be reviewed by the outgoing GPB board, advisor and current/outgoing council presidents. Appointed candidates will be notified by Wednesday, **September 25th**, at the latest. Once again, there will be no presentation/speeches, we will only be reviewing your application and supplementary documents.

Application deadline: The deadline to submit an application is Sunday, **September 22nd**.

Criteria for Membership:

GPB, Chapter Presidents, Council Presidents and the Advisor shall make every effort to select a diverse programming board representing a broad cross-section of men and women that comprise the University of Illinois at Chicago fraternity and sorority community. Each board member must meet and maintain the following criteria:

1. Be a full-time undergraduate student of UIC
2. Be in good standing with the University of Illinois at Chicago
3. Have a minimum cumulative overall 2.6 GPA
4. Be in good standing with his or her respective fraternity or sorority
5. Currently hold or have previously held a leadership position within their chapter or the Fraternity and Sorority Life community
